Occidental

Occidental has been the Kistler family’s pinot noir project with a singular focus - to make world-class pinot noir from unique sites on the headlands in the Freestone-Occidental area. From the early 1990s, Steve Kistler believed that the climate and soils on the uplifted marine terraces and ridges around the town of Bodega would be ideal for growing distinctive pinot noir vineyards. He founded a small, pinot noir brand in 2011, and built a state-of-the-art winery just east of the town of Bodega – overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

Radio-Coteau

The estate lies ten miles from the ocean on a ridgetop above Occidental, where the land is uniformly comprised of fine sandy loam Goldridge soil – the remnants of an ancient seabed, revered for providing excellent drainage and moderate fertility. A part of the Sonoma Coast, but bordering on the Green Valley and Russian River Valley AVAs, the area experiences moderate rainfall seasonally through the winter months, and the overall cool, coastal climate provides for extended ripening and good flavor development. It is this distinctive terroir that provides the platform for our non-interventionist winegrowing practices, encapsulating our intention to preserve, capture, reflect, and respect the property’s unique sense of place.

Senses

Senses began as a shared dream among three childhood friends raised in Occidental. Christopher Strieter, Max Thieriot and Myles Lawrence-Briggs followed disparate paths into finance, acting, and law before returning to their roots to honor the terroir of their backyard. Today, it is a partnership with legendary winemaker Thomas Rivers Brown, producing world-class Chardonnay and Pinot noir from the West Sonoma Coast and Russian River Valley. Their philosophy is simple: source from the most exceptional sites and allow the fruit's natural energy and sense of place shine. The portfolio is anchored by storied estate vineyards such as B.A. Thieriot and lifetime grower relationships

Williams Selyem

Founded in the heart of the Russian River Valley, Williams Selyem began with two ambitious ideals: to craft wines of uncompromising excellence and to build genuine, personal relationships with every customer. Like many remarkable stories, the origins of the winery were shaped by a measure of serendipity. When a grower with surplus fruit offered Burt Williams several tons of free grapes in the 1970s, he discovered an unexpected passion and natural gift for winemaking. And had Burt and his partner, Ed Selyem, been able to afford the French Burgundies they admired so deeply, they may never have ventured into crafting their own Pinot Noir. What began as a modest home winemaking project intended solely for personal enjoyment soon evolved into one of the most revered names in American wine. Together, Burt and Ed redefined the potential of domestic Pinot Noir, establishing a benchmark for excellence while helping elevate the Russian River Valley to international recognition as one of the world's premier wine-growing regions.
